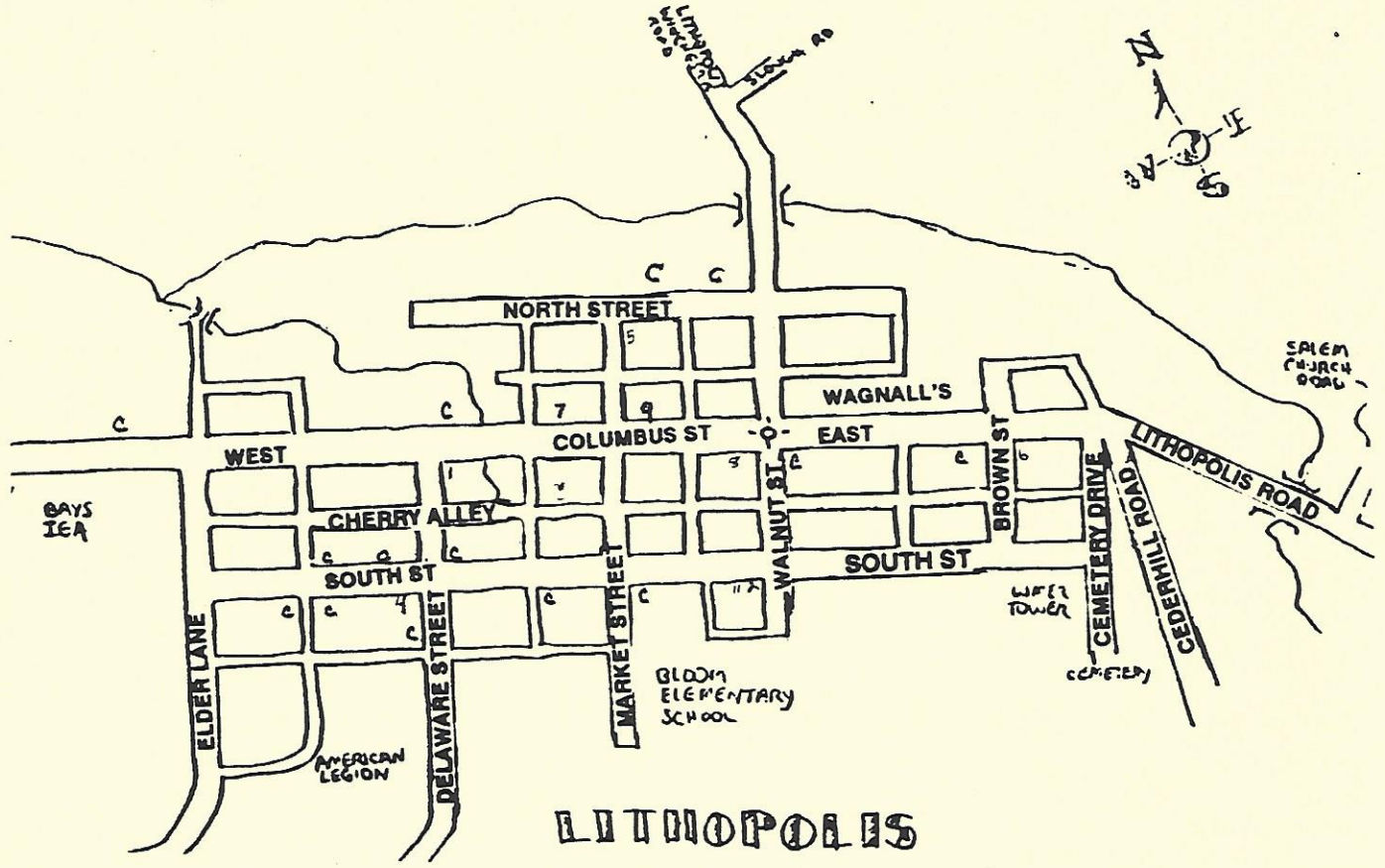

LOCATIONS AND DESCRIPTIONS

c - indicates log cabin.



1. Elkhorn Hotel - Located at 81 West Columbus Street. Hotel from early 1800's to end of stagecoach era. Presently a four apartment complex. President William Henry Harrison reported to have stayed at the Elkhorn.
2. Unassigned.
3. Presbyterian Church - Located at 75 East South Street. First Church in Lithopolis. Established in 1829.
4. St. John Lutheran Church - Located at 133 West South Street. Established in 1855.
5. United Methodist Church - Located at 81 North Market Street. Established in 1887.
6. Village Well - Located at corner of East Columbus and Brown Streets. Used by Anna Willis (Wagnall) to draw drinking water.
7. 2 Story Log Cabin - Located at 34 West Columbus Street. Used as The Parr House Hotel during early the 1800's.
8. 1 Story Log Cabin - Located at 87 East Columbus Street. Built in 1820, the cabin is part of the Log House Cottage Store.
9. 2 Story Frame - Located at 20 East Columbus Street. Built by Joseph Linn in 1836, oldest part of building was a Milinery Store. Presently the Lantern Post & a residence.
10. Unassigned.
11. Bloom School - This two story brick school was located at 55 East South Street from 1893 to 1944. The Lithopolis Masonic Lodge is presently on this site. The marker shows an etching of the School.
